



## **CONSTRUCTION ALERT: NEW RIVER BRIDGE OUTAGES**

- WHAT:** All Aboard Florida is making a significant investment and rehabilitating the New River bridge in the City of Fort Lauderdale prior to the introduction of the Brightline passenger rail service.
- Additional closure periods are required to complete the rehabilitation. All Aboard Florida worked with the Marine Industries Association of South Florida to schedule the work.
- The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) approved the deviation to the existing operating schedule.
- WHEN:** **Sunday, April 2, 10 p.m. through Monday, April 3, 8 a.m.**  
Bridge closed to marine traffic
- Monday, April 3 through Sunday, April 16**  
**During these dates and between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m.,** the bridge will be operated by crane and in accordance with its normal schedule.  
**During these dates and between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m.,** the bridge will be in the down position but will open to marine traffic on-demand. The openings will be slightly longer due to the bridge operating with a crane. Mariners are encouraged to call the FEC bridge tender, 305-889-5572 or 954-325-0581. The bridge tender will monitor Marine Channel 9.
