The South Andrews Master Plan emphasizes the following key elements:

- A Vision that captures the community's desire for the future of the area.
- Identification of issues to be addressed to encourage the realization of the Vision over time.
- A plan to improve the economic development in the area by identifying opportunities along the corridor.
- A plan that improves the image of the area.
- Identification of pilot projects for capital improvements.
- A phasing strategy for implementation of the plan.
