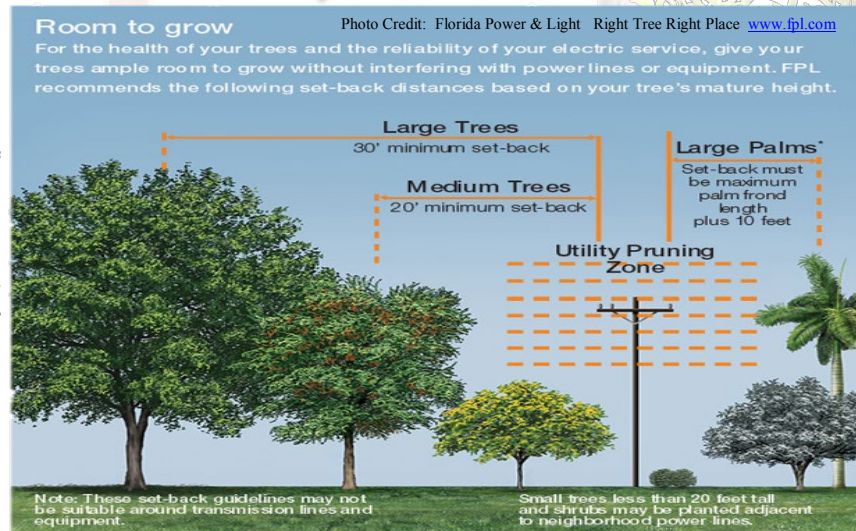

Replacement Specifications:

- ✿ The caliper replacement requirement for shade trees will include, but not be limited to, this list. Trees not listed require city approval for planting.
- ✿ Replacement shade tree size is a minimum of 10' tall at time of installation. Note that a 10' tall tree is approximately a 2" caliper.
- ✿ The clear trunk replacement requirement for palms will include, but not be limited to, this list. Palms not listed require city approval for planting.
- ✿ Replacement palm size is a minimum of 8' clear trunk for large palms and 4' clear trunk for small palms at time of installation.
- ✿ All plant material must be Florida #1 grade or better at time of installation.
