We depart for Ft Myers and the ever-so-popular Broadway Palm Dinner Theatre to honor the life and music of one of America’s greatest song writers in the last two centuries. George Cohan was an American Entertainer, playwright, lyricist, actor, singer, dancer and producer in the decade before World War I and is considered the father of American musical comedy. Cohan was born in Rhode Island 1878 to Irish Catholic parents who were traveling Vaudeville performers. He joined them on stage while still an infant. By his teens he started writing original skits and songs for the family and introduced his first big hit “Give My Regards To Broadway” in 1904. He became one of the leading Tin Pan Alley songwriters, publishing upwards of 1500 original songs noted for their catchy melodies and clever lyrics. Some of his major hit songs included “You’re A Grand Old Flag”, “Yankee Doodle Dandy”, “The Small Town Gal”, and the popular war song, “Over There”. In the 1930’s he starred in films with Claudette Colbert, Jimmy Durante, Celeste Holm and James Cagney who won an Oscar for “Yankee Doodle Dandy”. Cohan died at age 64 from abdominal cancer, but his legacy will live forever in the songs that are still sung by the children of today. Don’t miss out on this very special tribute to George M Cohan. Prior to the show we will indulge in Broadway Palm’s very lavish buffet, which is a prelude to this special American musical.
