

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 8th day of July, 2010, is by and between the City of Fort Lauderdale, a Florida municipality, ("City"), whose address is 100 North Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301-1016, and Blosser & Sayfie, P.A., a Florida corporation, ("Contractor"), whose address and phone are 450 East Las Olas Boulevard, Suite 1500, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301, Phone: 954-523-2427, Fax: 954-523-9146.

WHEREAS, the City issued Request for Proposal Number 195-10353 ("RFP"), and the Contractor submitted a proposal in response to the RFP; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting beginning on July 7, 2010, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale approved an agreement with Contractor for the goods or services described in the RFP,

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the City and the Contractor covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Contractor agrees to provide to the City state legislative lobbyist services in accordance with and in strict compliance with the specifications, terms, conditions, and requirements set forth in the RFP and any and all addenda thereto beginning July 12, 2010, and ending July 11, 2011.

2. This contract form G-110 Rev. 01/10, the RFP, any and all addenda to the RFP, and the Contractor's proposal in response to the RFP are integral parts of this Contract, and are incorporated herein.

3. In the event of conflict between or among the contract documents, the order of priority shall be as follows:

- First, this contract form, G-110 Rev. 01/10;
- Second, any and all addenda to the City's RFP in reverse chronological order;
- Third, the RFP;
- Fourth, the Contractor's response to any addendum requiring a response;
- Fifth, the Contractor's response to the RFP.

4. The Company warrants that the goods and services supplied to the City pursuant to this Contract shall at all times fully conform to the specifications set forth in the ~~ITB~~ ^{RFP} and be of the highest quality. In the event the City, in the City's sole discretion, determines that any product or service supplied pursuant to this Contract is defective or does not conform to the specifications set forth in the RFP the City reserves the right unilaterally to cancel an order or cancel this Contract upon written notice to the Contractor, and reduce commensurately any amount of money due the Contractor.

5. The City may cancel this Contract upon written notice to the Contractor in the event the Contractor fails to furnish the goods or perform the services as described in the ~~ITB~~ ^{RFP} within 30 days following written notice to the Contractor.

6. The Contractor shall not present any invoice to the City that includes sales tax (85-8012514506C-7) or federal excise tax (59-6000319).

7. Contractor shall direct all invoices in duplicate for payment to Finance Department, City of Fort Lauderdale, 100 N. Andrews Avenue, 6th Floor, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301. Any applicable discount MUST appear on the invoice.

8. The first paragraph of Section 08 of Part IV of the RFP is deleted.





ONE

Additionally, Jim Blosser who has over 11 years of direct lobbying experience and Alain Jean who has 9 years of direct lobbying experience will comprise the team for Ft. Lauderdale's engagement. The engagement with the City of Ft. Lauderdale will not have any significant impact on current clients serviced by Blosser & Sayfie. Justin and Alain regularly monitor the Florida Legislature's sessions and committee meetings. Justin also monitors the Florida Cabinet as well as the activity of the State's regulatory

authorities. Due to the length and intensity of a legislative session, Alain will provide weekly updates to the City on the actions of the Legislature. Alain will also advise the City of committee weeks, budget requests or any regulatory actions taking place that may impact Ft. Lauderdale. Once the City and the Firm determine the impact of an action we will quickly put a strategy in place and execute it. When the legislative session concludes, the Firm will develop an end of session report for the City. During the summer months or when the City deems appropriate, the Firm will work with the City to develop a legislative agenda for the upcoming session. Blosser & Sayfie has enjoyed many successes over the years. (5 accomplishments in the past 5 years)

1. In 2007, our Firm successfully represented Triple H Ranch, owned by H. Wayne Huizenga, and DeBuys Property Investment Group, Ltd., and passed legislation that moved the Broward-Palm Beach County line to accommodate our clients' property. Due to multi-jurisdictional impact of this legislation, this effort required extensive coordination with a number of governmental entities, including the City of Parkland, Broward County and Palm Beach County. Our Firm navigated the legislative and executive branch processes and successfully advocated moving the Broward-Palm Beach County line for the 2000-acre wedge of land along Lox Road and the Hillsboro Canal. The moving of the county dividing line was the first significant shift in the boundary in almost 100 years.
2. In order to effectuate moving the Broward-Palm Beach County line referenced in #1 above, the Legislature required that the Department of Community Affairs approve a Land Use Amendment submitted by Palm Beach County removing University Drive from their planning map. From 2007 to 2009, our Firm worked with a number of different governmental agencies to successfully obtain the necessary support from the Secretary of the Department of Community Affairs for the comprehensive plan amendment. In the course of our successful representation, we represented our clients in extensive and arduous negotiations with the Florida Department of Transportation and DOT Secretary Stephanie Köpelousos as well as the Broward and Palm Beach Metropolitan Planning Organizations, the South Florida Regional Planning Council and Broward and Palm Beach Counties. The Cities of Coral Springs and Coconut Creek were strongly opposed and aggressively lobbied against the proposed comprehensive plan amendment regarding the elimination of University Drive, however, our efforts and our advocacy were successful

in ultimately achieving the necessary approval from the Secretary of the Florida Department of Community Affairs.

3. Our Firm successfully represented the University of Miami in 2007-2008 in a land swap between the Florida Department of Transportation, the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida as well as the City of Miami. The property that the University of Miami received in this transaction is the site of the University's proposed new Life Sciences Building. The effort to achieve this swap of property was exceptionally delicate due to the need to comply with state regulations regarding the disposal of state land such that this land could be ultimately acquired by the University without being deemed a sale, which would have required a RFP selection process for prospective acquirers of the property. Our Firm successfully achieved full compliance with those regulations while at the same time allowing University of Miami to acquire this valuable property that will now be used to diversify South Florida's economy and provide high-wage jobs in our state. This representation required extensive discussions, negotiations and advocacy with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, acting on behalf of the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund, as well as the District 6 office of the Florida Department of Transportation. This land swap was ultimately approved by the Florida Governor and the Cabinet during a meeting of the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund. Our Firm successfully represented the University with all members of the Florida Cabinet including the Governor.
4. In 2009, our Firm successfully represented the City of Hollywood in its efforts to ensure that the Governor's Office negotiated a revenue stream for impacted local governments with the Seminole Tribe of Florida in the Tribal Compact negotiations. Due to impacts on the use of the services of the location of the Seminole Hard Rock Casino just outside the jurisdiction of Hollywood, the City of Hollywood retained our Firm to ensure that the final Compact negotiated between the Governor and the Seminole Tribe of Florida included a provision that would ensure a revenue stream for impacted local governments due to the addition of Class 3 games including blackjack, other banked card games and Las Vegas-style slot machines at the Seminole Hard Rock Casino. The Compact that was signed by the Governor and the Tribe in 2009 ultimately included this provision.
5. In 2005, our Firm successfully represented Freedom HealthCare on a regulatory issue with the Florida Department of Health regarding the operation of some of its pharmacies. Our office worked with the Secretary of the Department of Health as well as the legal counsel's office of the Department of Health to obtain a letter from the Secretary providing a favorable interpretation of state law in support of its business operations.
