



RIVERWALK SEAWALL REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The City of Fort Lauderdale is finalizing the design for a seawall replacement project along the Riverwalk. This project aims to enhance resilience and accessibility in the area by replacing approximately 500 feet of seawall on the north side of New River. The project location extends along the Riverwalk, between the City's pump house by the FEC railroad bridge on the west and the Andrews Avenue Bridge on the east.



Project Overview

- **Seawall Replacement:** Replacing approximately 500 feet of seawall.
- **Paver Reconstruction:** Repairing damaged brick pavers in the area.
- **Floating Docks:** Adding two floating docks to improve waterfront access.
- **Pump-Out Stations:** Installing two pump-out stations for boater convenience.
