- ✓ *Modifying sidewalk ramps for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance.*

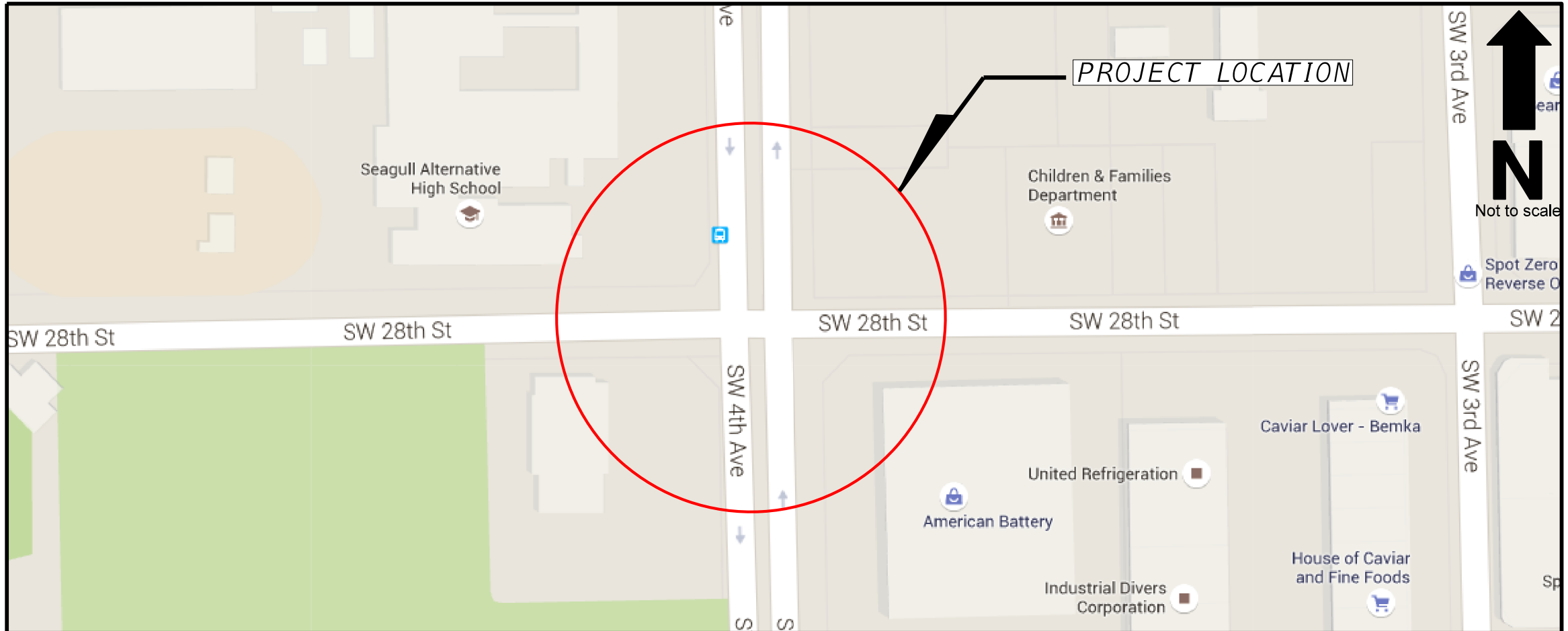
