### **Project Overview**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a \$15 million contract to Construct Group Corp. for the construction of sidewalks, multi-use pedestrian paths, and bicycle lanes along 48 roadways in Broward County. Construction began February 2, 2015 and will be completed by Summer 2018. This project is part of a larger \$100 million investment from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) to provide bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access throughout the Broward region. ### **Project Improvements**

Construction in Pompano Beach / Fort Lauderdale is expected to begin July 18, 2016.

#### **McNab Road from Cypress Road to US 1 / Federal Highway**

- Removing old asphalt, resurfacing, and restriping the corridor
- Widening the existing roadway to provide 5-foot bike lanes in each direction

#### **Cypress Road from McNab Road to Atlantic Boulevard**

- Removing old asphalt, resurfacing, and restriping the corridor
- Adding sharrow pavement markings (share the road arrows) to the outside lane in each direction

### **Traffic Impact**

Single lane closures can be expected between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. If necessary, flaggers will direct traffic.
