All neighbors and design professionals engaged in public realm design should join us on August 16 to learn more about the Design & Construction Manual.

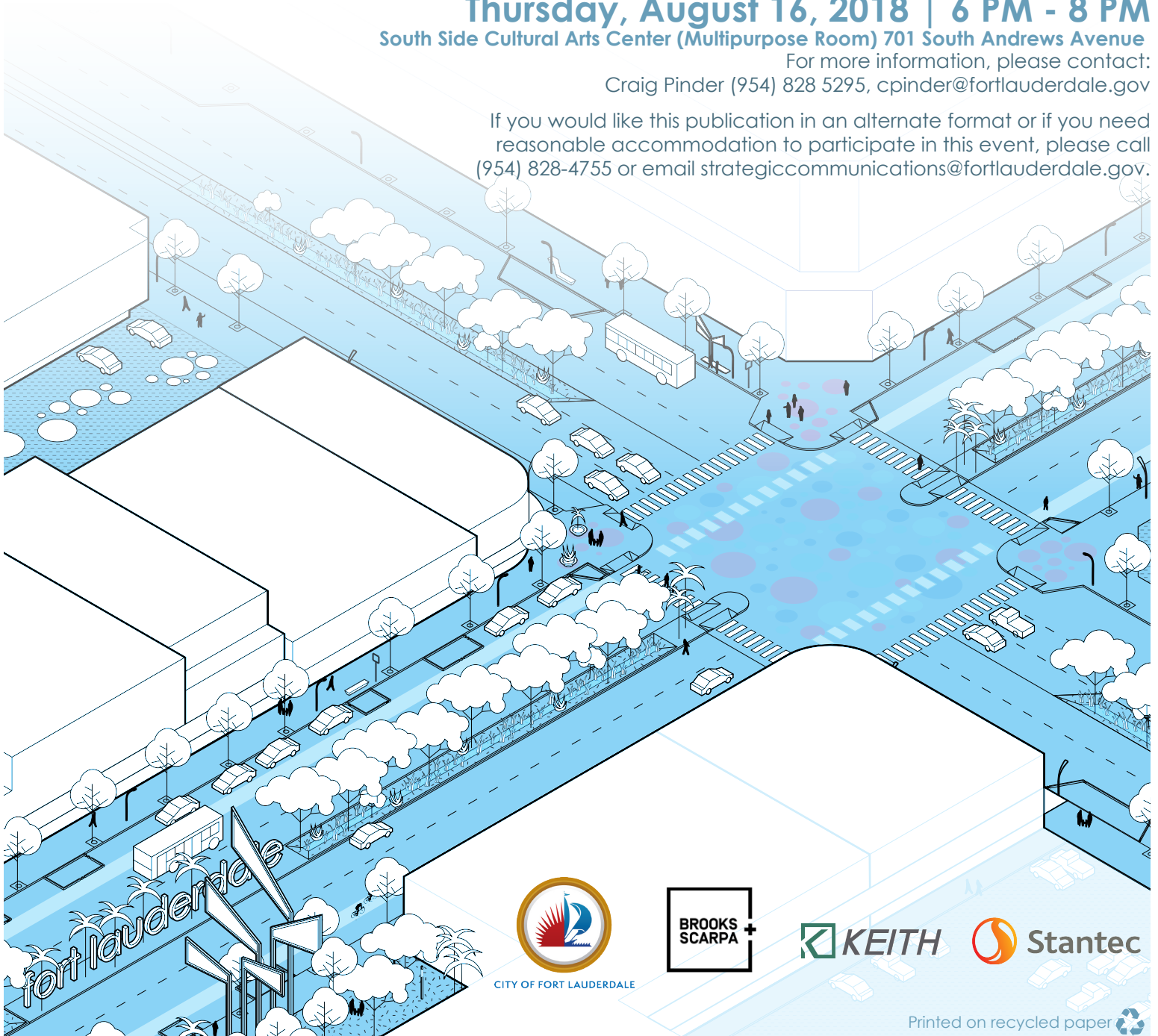
