## TRAFFIC INFORMATION

Expect traffic to be heavy in the vicinity of the Boat Show. Roadways that may be particularly impacted are State Road A1A between S.E. 17th Street and E. Sunrise Boulevard, as well as E. Sunrise Boulevard from N.E. 20th Avenue to Bayview Drive.

## **ILLEGAL PARKING LOTS**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department reminds neighbors that selling parking on private residential property is prohibited, and enforcement will take place throughout the event.
