Learn about the Tuskegee Airmen, aka Red Tails, who were pilots and support personnel – both military and civilian, male and female – that served with the segregated 332nd Fighter Group and 477th Bombardment Group during World War II and before the integration of the Armed Forces.

/// Visit the RISE ABOVE Traveling Exhibit, a panoramic, air-conditioned movie theater that inspires and educates people of all ages with the remarkable history of the Tuskegee Airmen. The theater is accessible via a lift for those seated in wheelchairs and scooters.

/// Tour the P-51C Mustang Tuskegee Airmen, a twice-restored, fully operational signature aircraft of the Red Tails.

/// Meet Tuskegee Airmen pilot Lieutenant Colonel George Hardy during the annual Aviation Safety Expo March 23, 2019 at FXE. Now in his mid-90s, Lieutenant Colonel Hardy is the youngest of the 13 known living Red Tail combat pilots.
