OVERVIEW

The A1A Streetscape Improvement Project includes updating the current landscaping, hardscaping, and lighting along A1A from the north end of the South Beach Parking Lot to Alhambra Street.

Planned Improvements Include:

- A new decorative wave patterned sidewalk
- Traffic bollards
- · Moving existing palm trees closer to the curb for improved pedestrian flow
- Smaller accent plantings near Las Olas Boulevard
- New lighting along the west side of A1A
- Renovating existing lighting with turtle-friendly, color changing LED fixtures
- Relocating lighting on the west side of A1A closer to the curb for improved pedestrian flow

Temporary lane closures or detours are anticipated during construction. The contractor will coordinate with the City of Fort Lauderdale to ensure businesses remain accessible and general access to the area is maintained for vehicles, pedestrians, bicyclists, and other modes of transportation.
