As we reopen Fort Lauderdale, the City is temporarily expanding access to outdoor spaces, such as streets and sidewalks, in an effort to facilitate social distancing for pedestrians and business patrons in key areas.

Las Olas Boulevard Business Sidewalk Expansion Permitted on Weekends

Businesses along Las Olas Boulevard between SE 6 Avenue and SE 11 Avenue will be able to expand their operations on to the sidewalk beginning Fridays at 7 a.m. through Mondays at 7 a.m. This expansion does not affect travel lanes or access to parking spaces. At least four feet of sidewalk on each side of the street must be maintained to enable pedestrian access and ADA-compliance.

Pedestrians should exercise caution and motorists should travel slowly through the area.
