Subject: Florida East Coast Railway – Notification of Crossing Maintenance

Annually, the Florida East Coast Railway (FEC) conducts field inspections of all grade crossings on the railway line to compile a list for their Grade Crossing Maintenance Program. The City has received notice that the following crossing locations are included in the 2021 calendar year maintenance plan:

The FEC has indicated the typical maintenance needs take approximately four days to complete with a full crossing closure; however, each location varies based on the location’s specific needs. The FEC has contracted with Gulfstream Engineering, to facilitate the administrative processes, which includes the submission of a Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) application. The MOT application will identify the overall impact, timeline, and detour route. City staff will share available project details with the public through the City’s LauderStreet portal (<https://gis.fortlauderdale.gov/lauderstreet>) and through the Strategic Communications division.
