WHEREAS, June marks the annual celebration of the progress that the LGBTQ+ community has made with equal rights and fairness in the United States and serves as a time to recommit ourselves to accomplishing the work of fighting discrimination and championing equality; and

whereas, during this month of June, the City of Fort Lauderdale will join with thousands of municipalities nationwide to honor the 52nd anniversary of the 1969 Stonewall Innriots in New York City that ignited the modern LGBTQ+ rights movement in America; and

WHEREAS, the community of Fort Lauderdale is proud to annually welcome more than 1.3 million LGBTQ+ guests from around the globe, making Fort Lauderdale a premiere international LGBTQ+ destination, while providing worldwide exposure to hundreds of LGBTQ+ businesses and tourism in South Florida; and

WHEREAS, The City of Fort Lauderdale proudly reaffirms its commitment to protecting and respecting the rights of every resident, business owner, student, and visitor who are a part of the LGBTQ+ community by flying the rainbow flag above City Hall during this month of June, for the fourth year in a row.
