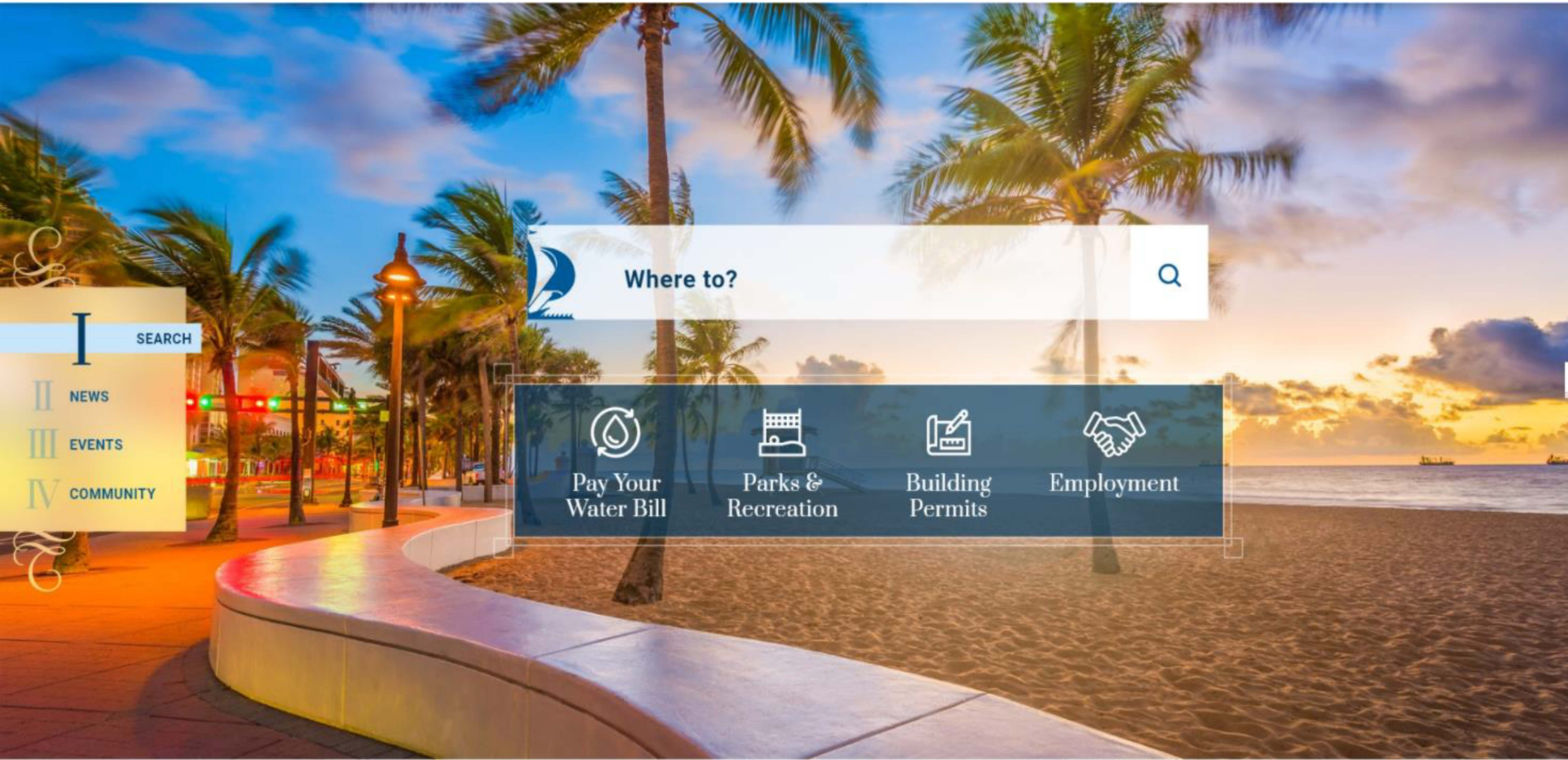

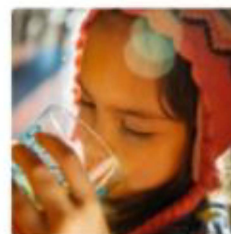

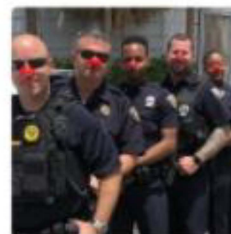
Marc Fein Appointed Strategic Communication Director
