If any person decides to appeal any decision made with respect to any matter considered at this public meeting or hearing, he/she will need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. SECTION 4. That the Infrastructure Task Force Advisory Committee shall meet at Fort Lauderdale City Hall at such times as determined by the Committee. The following shall apply to meetings held by the Committee Task Force:

 $A.\ At its first meeting, the Committee \ Task \ Force shall select its own chairperson and vice-chairperson from its members.$ 

- B. The Committee Task Force shall adopt rules or procedure for the conduct of its meetings.
- C. A majority of the appointed members shall constitute a quorum.

SECTION 5. The above appointments shall take effect immediately upon passage and adoption of this resolution.

SECTION 6. That the Infrastructure Task Force Advisory Committee shall commence on the date this Resolution is adopted and shall terminate on February 18, 2022, in eighteen (18) months from the date of adoption of this resolution.
