## Re: Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Update

The FY2022 Community Investment Plan (CIP) proposes providing \$30,000,000 of funding for a Citywide implementation of Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI). AMI refers to using a system of water meters, technical hardware, communication network, and software that allows the capability to provide real-time monitoring of water use by end users. Shifting to an AMI system may offer many benefits including improved accuracy of water meter readings, the opportunity for customers to receive automated alerts for leaks and monitor their own usage, and the elimination of costs for manual water meter reading. Early in 2021, the City Commission was briefed on a pilot program to evaluate AMI solutions. During the planning and development of the pilot program, the Public Works staff refocused the project and instead, proceed with the CIP project by developing a Citywide AMI solution through a standard procurement process.

Since the Commission approved CIP funding for this project in FY22, staff recommends (1) foregoing the pilot project; (2) retaining a consultant to assist with developing a Request for Proposal (RFP) for Citywide AMI; and (3) preparing and issuing an RFP for procurement of a Citywide AMI system.

Staff believes that the proposed path forward will provide the timeliest progress and the greatest overall benefit to the City and its neighbors.
