



RIVER OAKS NEIGHBORHOOD STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The City of Fort Lauderdale is proactively preparing for the future by investing in new stormwater infrastructure to reduce flooding throughout River Oaks. Crews from Ric-Man Construction Florida Inc. have started working in the neighborhood with a focus on the area north of SW 17 Street where they have been inspecting, cleaning, and lining pipes as well as installing new check valves. In late January 2022, crews commence work in the area south of SW 17 Street where they will be working on:

- installing stormwater infrastructure including tidal valves
- relocating sewer and water lines
- constructing sidewalk and swale areas
- restoring pavement and landscaping

This major work will include roadway excavations and the installation of a 72-inch diameter pipe. Crews are expected to be on site Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Overall completion is expected in November 2024.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Lane closures within the neighborhood are expected during construction. Detours will be set up in advance of closures and traffic control personnel will direct traffic through the work zone as needed. Access to driveways will be maintained. Please follow posted signs and drive with caution in the area.
