SUBJECT: Pickleball Courts at George English Tennis Center (GETC)

The City of Fort Lauderdale approved a 200-million-dollar bond referendum in March 2019 to make improvements to our park system. As such, we have been diligently working on the development and implementation of these park improvements.

The Parks and Recreation Department in consultation with the Coral Ridge Neighborhood plan to add six (6) pickleball courts including lights and fencing to be paid for out of the bond dollars for George English Park for a total amount of \$187,540.00. The anticipated project duration will be roughly 12-16 weeks from start to finish.

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting approval to move forward with park bond dollars to fund the installation of these courts.
