Phase I

- Stormwater infrastructure installation and driveway restoration along SW 21 St, SW 22 St and SW 23 St.
- Watermain installation along SW 19 Ave.
- Watermain relocation along SW 21 St.
- Staging and installation of stormwater drainage piping within the River Oaks Preserve.

Phase II

- Potholing activities along SW 20 St.
