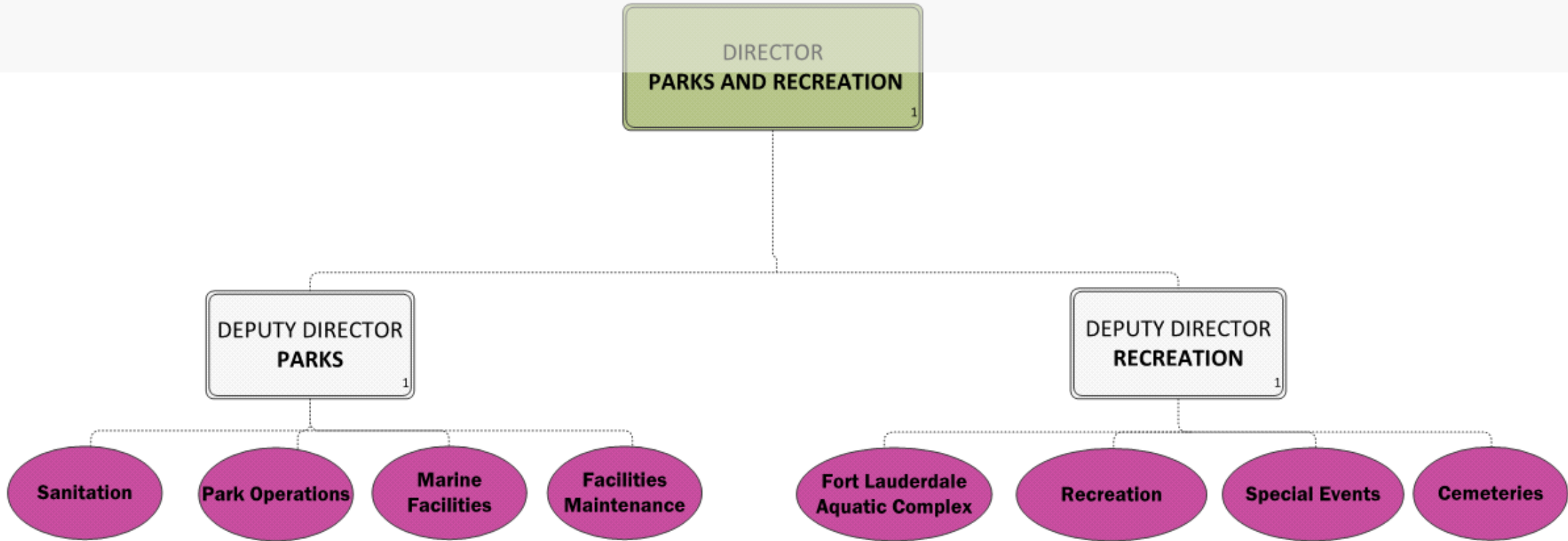


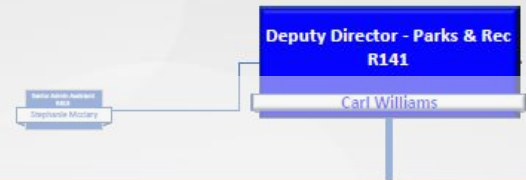

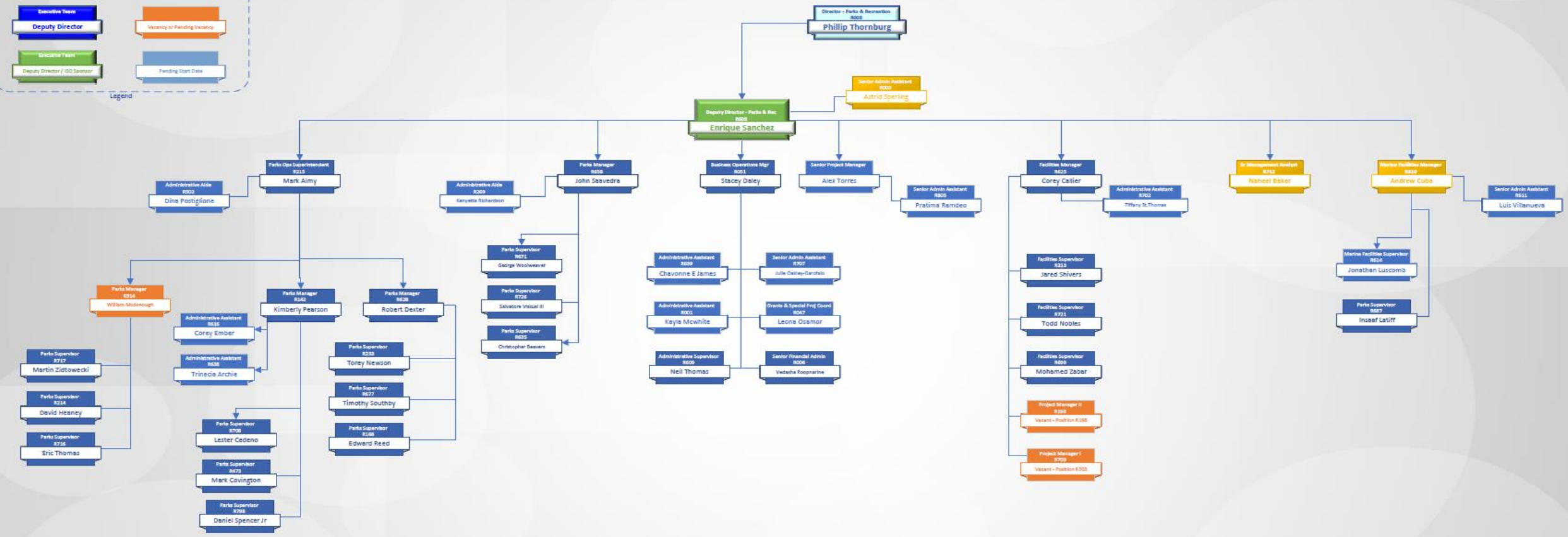






Public Information Recreation Fort Lauderdale Aquatic Center Cemetery

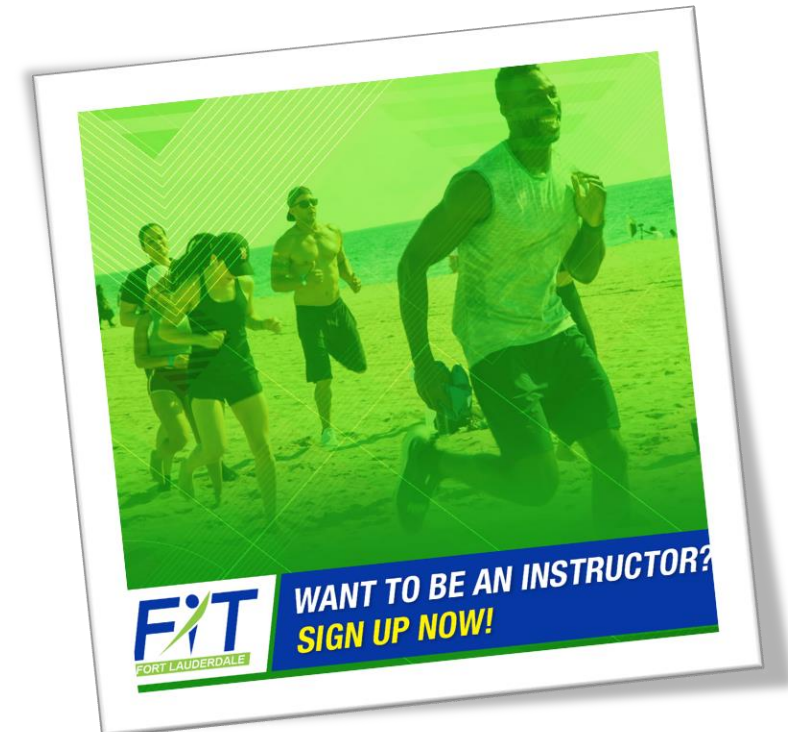

- December 2022: Comprehensive Agreement executed by City
- January 2023: Commence DRC process

Cemeteries

- **4 Cemeteries in our City**
 - *Evergreen Cemetery*- one of the oldest cemeteries in Broward County
 - *Lauderdale Memorial Park Cemetery*- property has a veterans' garden with a monument to honor all veterans that served our country and host the area's largest Memorial Day Events
 - *Sunset Memorial Gardens Cemetery*- City purchased the land and opened the 30-acre cemetery in 1961
 - *Woodlawn Cemetery*- historical resting place of many pioneering African-American residents

Major Goals:

- Develop a robust and trustworthy data base and information system
- Meet the service expectation of the citizens of Fort Lauderdale
- Maximize the developed and undeveloped property for Cemetery use to meet future burial needs and trends
- Ensure the Cemetery system continues with financial stability without the need for dependency on the General Fund

Facilities

Sanitation

- Bulk trash division is responsible for the residential bulk trash & yard waste collection.
- Clean Team keeps sidewalks, bus stops and park restrooms clean.

Parks Maintenance

- Park staff is responsible for keeping our 105 City parks clean, green, well maintained and inviting.
- 870 acres of park space include 4 miles of public beach.
