Re: Special Event Traffic - Advance Notice

At the February 7, 2023, Commission Meeting, the City Commission noted concerns about special event traffic and the need to have additional public notice. Specifically, the City Commission relayed concerns about motorists not having enough advance notice to avoid the special event area and the associated congestion.

For new event applications with over 5,000 attendees that are held in the central beach area, the City will require additional Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) devices to be placed outside of the immediate special event area. For these events, the following locations will require MOT electronic message boards notifying motorist of the special event:

- A. State Road A1A between NE 30<sup>th</sup> St. and NE 26<sup>th</sup> St. (Southbound traffic)
- B. Sunrise Boulevard between Middle River Dr. and Bayview Dr. (Eastbound traffic)
- C. Las Olas Boulevard between SE 13<sup>th</sup> Ave. and SE 15<sup>th</sup> Ave. (Eastbound traffic)
- D. SE 17th Street between Cordova Rd. and Eisenhower Blvd. (Eastbound traffic)



The goal is to have each of these signs deployed seven days before the special event period.
