- **Part time Salary Increase -** This salary increase will offer more competitive pay rate to ensure that the most qualified applicants are recruited and further operated with sufficient staff-to-children ratio. Proposing base pay increase to the following 2 part time positions
 - Recreation Clerk
 - Recreation Worker
- **Special Event Enhancements** Additional funding to cover the subsequent contract increases seen in special events. The funding enhancement would be spent on improvements to sound, stage and lighting, catering, inflatables, and equipment rentals, in addition to providing for larger entertainment and expanding children's activities. Enhancement includes new event in District I
