GENERAL INFORMATION / INTENT

The City of Fort Lauderdale is soliciting requests for proposals (RFP) from qualified professional firms, hereinafter referred to as the Contractor, to provide management, coordination, and staffing to further the City's Parks and Recreation Department goal to activate four open space areas on the Barrier Island. The areas include Fort Lauderdale Beach Park, Oceanside Park, Las Olas Garage Amenity Deck, and the Intracoastal promenade south of the Las Olas Bridge.

The successful firm will have proven experience in managing, coordinating, and promoting special events, activating public and/or private areas for public enjoyment and securing sponsorships, working with governmental and non-governmental agencies and businesses, and marketing and promoting activities at the four sites. All programming must be approved in advance by the Director of Parks and Recreation or his/her designee PRIOR to advertising and marketing the event(s). Event type, days, hours, expected attendance, etc.

The City reserves the right to block out dates for City events throughout the year. These include but are not limited to July 4, the Saturday before Memorial Day, the Winterfest Boat Parade, typically held the 2nd Saturday of December, and the Holiday Lighting event, typically held two days prior to Thanksgiving.

SCOPE OF SERVICE

Task 1: Develop, Coordinate, and Promote Special Events, Including Sponsorships.

- 1. Develop, coordinate, and promote events at the four sites on the Barrier Island. Plan, coordinate and facilitate the proposed events with the City of Fort Lauderdale, Broward County, non-governmental agencies, and businesses as required.
- 2. Seek outside sponsors to provide free events.
- 3. Enhance, expand, and develop new marketing initiatives using a variety of media platforms.

Task 2: Activate the four open space areas with various entertainment/activities to maximize the use of the areas.

- 1. Enhance and expand current marketing efforts initiated by the Business Improvement District, Convention & Visitors Bureau, City of Fort Lauderdale, and Chamber of Commerce.
- Provide a variety of proposed events at each of the four locations to satisfy the
 entertainment and recreational needs of various constituents. Events should include a mix
 of free events and may include but are not limited to free concert series, farmers markets,
 running events, triathlons, festivals, and other events and activities promoting the City and
 these amenities.

Task 3: Execute Work Program

- 1. Implement activation initiatives as recommended by the Parks and Recreation Director or his/her designated representative.
- 2. Provide a tentative schedule for activation once the contract is approved
