CERT - Community Emergency Response Team - New Member Orientation/Training

Being prepared in an emergency situation is critical. Following a major disaster, first responders who provide fire and medical services will not be able to meet the demand for service typically rendered. The local population will have to rely on each other for help in order to meet their immediate life saving, and life sustaining needs. The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program helps train people to be better prepared to respond to emergency situations in their communities. When emergencies happen, CERT members can give critical support to first responders, provide immediate assistance to victims, and organize spontaneous volunteers at a disaster site. CERT members can also help with non-emergency projects that help improve the safety of the community. This course is spread over two consecutive Saturdays with hands on training and in depth instructions. *New members must attend both trainings to receive CERT certification.*

CERT Training includes:

- Introduction to Incident Command System
- Disaster Preparedness
- Disaster Fire Suppression
- Basic Disaster Medical Operations
- Light Search and Rescue Operations
- Radio Communications and much more
