Parking Lot Closures & Pedestrian Access Information

The 2015 Tortuga Music Festival will begin setup in the parking lot at Fort Lauderdale Beach Park on the morning of Wednesday, April 1. The southern portion of the parking lot will be unavailable April 1-16 for pedestrian and vehicular access. The northern portion of the parking lot will be unavailable April 6-14 for pedestrian and vehicular access. The sidewalk along the west side of A1A will remain open. While these restrictions are in effect, Fort Lauderdale Beach will be accessible by using the entrance just north of the parking lot across from the Oasis Café, located at 600 Seabreeze Boulevard. The Fort Lauderdale Beach Park parking lot will re-open for full pedestrian and vehicular access on Thursday, April 16.
