Re: Marine Vessel Sewage Pump Out Stations

At the October 1, 2024, City Commission Conference Meeting, Commissioner Sturman requested information regarding the City's marine vessel pump out stations. The City operates four pump out stations that are available to any vessel at no-charge.

The four locations include:

- Marshall Point
- Smoker Park
- Cooley's Landing Marina
- Cox's Landing Boat Ramp
- 501 S. New River Drive 450 SW 7th Avenue 1784 SE 15th Street

410 SW 4th Avenue



The four stations are available 24 hours a day for self-service and 8:30am to 4:00pm for assisted service. If a boater has any questions regarding its use, they can contact the City's marina division at (954) 828-5423 or via marine radio VHF channel 9. As part of the upcoming Riverwalk improvements, additional pump out stations are being designed for future implementation.
